Missions Spotlight

Steve & Jenell Bender (STEP Missionaries)-Steve and Jenell were approved as BBFI missionaries to Korea in September 1983. After arriving on the field in 1984, they faithfully served in Korea for nearly 14 years. In 1998, the Lord led them back to the United States, where Steve served for two years as an associate pastor before moving to Springfield, Missouri. There, he served for 25 years as an Associate Mission Director with Baptist Bible Fellowship International, overseeing missionary care and encouraging missionaries serving around the world. In September 2025, the Lord called the Benders back into full-time missionary service. They were reinstated as BBFI missionaries through the STEP program and now travel to encourage, assist, and minister to missionaries across the globe.

We will share an update on the Benders ministry and pray for them during our Wednesday evening service.
